LITURGICAL MINISTRY

DEVELOPING PARISH LITURGY TEAMS

For those who are interested in liturgy, already serve on a liturgy committee, or would like to connect with others on all things liturgical. Topics could include the environment, communication, Liturgical Documents, and Resources. (1-2hrs)

LITURGY PREPARATION FOR THE EASTER TRIDUUM

Celebrating Easter to the full. Knowing the liturgical options when it comes to baptisms, RCIA, and other liturgical features during the Triduum. (60 min)

LITURGICAL MUSIC

Exploring relevant liturgical music choices for today and working with the Parish to engage musical leaders. All workshops run for 1-2hrs or can be part of a half/full day. Focus can be:

- unifying music within a Parish across all the music ministry volunteers. How to introduce 'new' music and how often the repertoire can be added to.
- developing a music ministry in a Parish that currently has very little live music. How to invite the next generation of musicians to offer their talents and build their confidence in understanding the liturgy. This is a great workshop for schools as well.
- How to accompany on guitar, piano, or a full band. Choir/Cantor techniques and skills to lead the congregation in active and full participation in the Mass.
- Copyright – for Parish secretaries and/or music ministers. Understanding how to attribute composers and adequately display the Parish copyright license and how to report to OneLicense so that composers are compensated. A social justice issue.

MINISTERING HOLY COMMUNION

What does it mean to be called an 'extraordinary minister'? This workshop prepares parish members to be able to minister communion during Mass. The session covers the history of Communion and the procedure of distributing Communion. (60 min)

PROCLAIMING THE WORD

Proclaiming God's Word means more than being a good reader! We can provide a training session for all those on the reading roster at their local parish. (60 min)

BAPTISM TEAM TRAINING

Learning to work with families to prepare them for the sacrament of Baptism and the ongoing journey of faith. A ministry of hospitality in welcoming families to the church. (2 hrs)

BEREAVEMENT MINISTRY TRAINING

How to prepare Funeral liturgies and Masses for the deceased. How to support the bereaved in a pastoral setting. (2 hrs)

HOSPITALITY & WELCOME

Provide practical strategies and tips in developing a welcoming Parish to all that walk through its doors. (60 mins)

MINISTERING TO THE SICK

Preparing parish members to be able to minister communion to the sick. Those attending this workshop must be currently serving as an Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion in the Archdiocese of Adelaide. (60 min)

PARISH PASTORAL COUNCIL

- Role & functions of a PPC in the Parish. (60 mins)
- How to create a Strategic Plan for your parish. (90 mins)
- Working with current PPC members to develop vision and mission statements and strategic planning. (Individual PPC's part of a half/full day)

RCIA TEAM TRAINING

It falls to every parish community to welcome and receive those who desire an encounter with Jesus and a life of faith. These workshops covering each period of the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) – offering practical strategies to welcome inquirers and lead them through initiation into a lifetime of faith regardless of your parish resources. We will explore both the formational aspects and the liturgical steps that move people through each period. (4 workshops x 2hrs)

VOLUNTEER RECRUITMENT & RETENTION

Practical workshop that explores best practices for recruiting and retaining volunteers within Parish life. (90 mins)
